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Day 1: Inauguration and Awareness Programme for Scholarship

The great inaugural ceremony was followed by an event to round up the first day of the Students' Week, namely an Event Awareness Programme for Scholarships, presided over by Mr. Jitmohan Saha, Head, Department of Bengali, Harishchandrapur College as the Event-in-Charge. The speakers whose memorable discussions marked the event included Mr. Jitmohan Saha and Mr. Nasim Parvege.











Day 2: Interaction with the guardians and free heath check-up camp

The second day of the Students' Week celebrations held by Harishchandrapur College, Pipla, Malda, began with a meeting aimed to facilitate an interface between the teachers of the College and the parents and guardians of the students. This was held in order to furnish the parents with a platform to voice their requirements and concerns pertaining to the growth and progress of their wards. They were duly counselled by the teachers about strategies and modalities which may be implemented in order to brightly shape the minds of the future, all the while ensuring that the learning curve never becomes so steep as to be altogether insurmountable and thus daunting for the students.





The latter event of the day revolved around the organizing of a Free Health Check-up Camp for all the students. Day 3: Career Counselling Programme

The students were initiated into fresh realms of thought concerning the breadth of their career possibilities. The session, led by Mr. Arpan Sarki, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science proved to be decidedly enriching and a resounding success, turning out to be the focal event of the day.







Day 4: Quiz Competition Programme


